

Thanks to a patented semisynthesis process, Indena today is making better use of the yew grown in its plantations. For this new, exclusive process synthesises anti-tumour molecules such as Paclitaxel from 10-Deacetylbaccatin, an intermediate obtained from the yew tree. And this means a significant increase in the amount of taxanes produced from a given amount of biomass. A new facility for semisynthesis is now in full production.



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
